



**GUIDELINES ON THE SELECTION/TRY-OUT OF VARSITY PLAYERS**  
School Year 2017-2018

1. All students/aspirants for membership in any sports varsity team must be officially enrolled student of IPSA.
2. Try-outs to select and fill the vacant slots in any sports varsity team shall be conducted within the month of July. All Team Coaches shall submit their respective official line-up first week of August.
3. Membership of Varsity players who excelled in the previous year as evidenced by major awards/medals garnered/received in the last major sports tournament will be retained. Moreover, he/she shall be of good moral and exemplary behavior with no derogatory record on file, attended/participated in at least 80% of the total number of training sessions and official games.
4. Name of varsity players who were retained and available slots to the varsity team shall be announced prior to the try-outs.
5. Previous varsity players who failed to secure a place in the medal ranking during the previous sports tournament shall submit himself/herself to the scheduled try-out sessions.
6. Selection of varsity players shall be based on their skills, performance and try-outs attendance in the sports discipline of their choice. Players are selected by at least three (3) member panel of judges. Judges should not be in any way related to any aspirant.
7. All participants in the scheduled selection try-out shall submit a Parental Waiver of Consent duly signed by the parents to the Team Coach two (2) school days before the selection try-out.
8. All participants shall comply with the age limit and other requirements in terms of tournament rules, regulations and eligibilities.
9. Varsity players who quit the varsity team at the middle of the year shall monetarily compensate the School equivalent to the cost of the uniform issued for the whole year.
10. Parents, Teachers, and Students are welcome to witness the try-outs but they should stay only in a designated place to maintain order and focus in the try-out area. Camera flash is not allowed where the try-out is being conducted.


